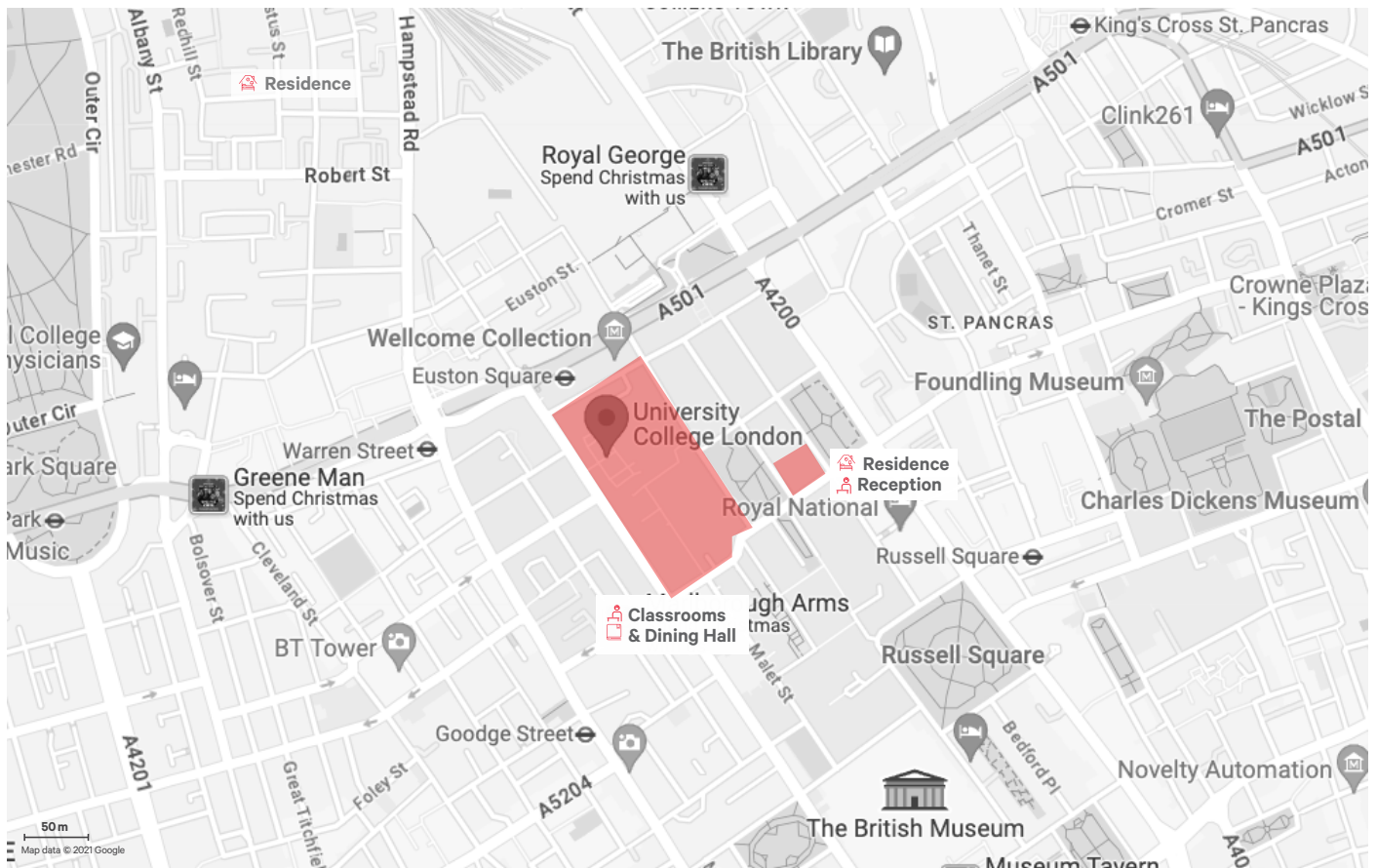

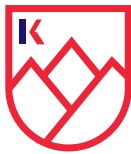
Free time
