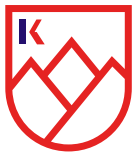

## Unsupervised Time and Sortie Libre

- ✓ Parents need to sign the parental consent form in order for students to leave the camp at specific time slots or have free time on excursions.
- ✓ Students are not allowed to leave the camp in the evening or during the night.
- ✓ Please note that all students have free time inside camp, however staff members are always present and supervising.
- ✓ Students who do not have parental consent will join the "Alpadia Lounge" after activities. They will play group games or have the option to visit local shops under supervision.
- ✓ Students who have parental consent can leave camp after the afternoon activity until the start of dinnertime without supervision.
- ✓ Students who have consent can have unsupervised time on excursions; for example to shop or eat independently (please note this may be in the evening). This would be during specific/pre-defined times only.
- ✓ Students who have parental consent can leave camp independently on Saturday mornings (this does not include departure day).
- ✓ Students who have parental consent will be allowed to walk alone to and from accommodation between meals, lessons and activities.

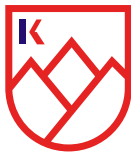

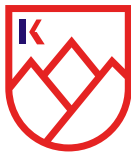
