

Adapted to Your Level

Prior to your stay, you will take an online evaluation test, after which you will be placed in a class that corresponds to your level.

Standard Course

20 lessons x 45 minutes per week

Every weekday, benefit from three hours of language classes in small groups with our engaging, experienced, and dynamic teachers.

Intensive Course

25 lessons x 45 minutes per week

On top of the Standard course, benefit from five additional lessons per week, focused mainly on oral communication, ideal for getting the most out of your group classes and encouraging rapid progress.

Private Course

5 lessons x 45 minutes per week

Take advantage of five additional private lessons per week to reach your personal objectives and achieve quick progression. Private lessons can only be combined with the Standard course.

Course Types

Student Supervision

Safety is our highest priority

We work hard to create the perfect environment for a language study stay. The supervision of our students is effective and discreet, adapted to the age group and the type of accommodation booked. In this way, each student gets the maximum possible benefit from their stay in complete safety. From the first day to the last, Alpadia team members are present and available to give the assistance requested by each student and to ensure their safety. Emergency numbers, available 24/7, are in service at each of the Alpadia course centres.

Internet & Telephone Access

Stay connected

The internet lets students stay in touch easily with their families. All Alpadia course centres provide free internet access. What's more, the course venues in the Alps are situated in regions benefitting from good mobile phone network coverage.

Additional Services

Unaccompanied Minors (UM) service

For your child's flight, we can offer you an **Unaccompanied Minors (UM)** service, provided in collaboration with the airline. Your child will be met at the airport by an airline representative and assisted throughout the journey. This service is designed for young children travelling alone and is strongly recommended for travellers under 13 years of age (some airlines even require it). Airlines will charge you the fees related to this service when you purchase your flight ticket; you will then need to register the UM service with Alpadia at the time of enrolment. This means your child will be collected by an Alpadia staff member on arrival, and assisted during the handover to an airline representative on the day of departure. With this service, young travellers are sure to be assisted at all times, at the airport and throughout their flight.

Insurance

Health/accident

During your enrolment for one of our programmes, you will need to certify that you are in possession of compulsory health and accident insurance coverage, valid in the country that you wish to visit. Alpadia provides insurance for students, from £/€/CHF/\$ 15 per week.

Cancellation

In addition, we strongly recommend that you take out cancellation insurance with an external provider, in case, at the last minute, you are unable to participate in the language study programme that you have booked.

Pocket money service

In the Alpadia residences, a pocket money service is available to the students. Functioning like a bank, the pocket money service is open every day, allowing students to deposit or withdraw money.

How to Enrol



1. Select the dates of the language programme you wish to book.

2. Insurance



Make sure to read carefully through the "insurance" clauses of our Terms and Conditions. Students who enrol for a language study programme with us must have health and accident insurance which is valid in Switzerland, France, Germany, USA, Malta and/or England. Health and travel insurance may be taken out during your enrolment with Alpadia. Cancellation insurance may be taken out with an external provider.



3. Enrol

4. Payment

A deposit of 300 EUR/GBP/CHF/CAD/USD (depending on where you study) will be required upon booking. The remaining payment would be due 4 weeks before your start date unless you need to apply for a visa. In this case, the whole payment would be needed before your visa appointment at the embassy.



5. Booking confirmation

Your study advisor will first make sure the dates you have selected are available for your stay and will contact you in case anything should be amended. Then within 48 hours, you will receive your booking confirmation and an invoice with the details of the language trip, the programme chosen, any special requirements and the method of transport selected for arrival and departure.



6. Apply for a visa (if required)

Should you require an official letter of invitation from Alpadia in order to apply for a visa, we will prepare such a letter for the Swiss, French, German or British embassy in your country upon receipt of payment. Please let us know whether you require such a letter.

7. Student Portal

Students will receive personal credentials to access their own session on the Alpadia student portal (scan the QR code to download). In this portal, you will be able to find:
